#### **GENERAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE**

By choosing an ARB Fridge Slide, you have bought a product that is one of the most sought after 4WD products in the world. Your fridge slide is a properly engineered, reliable, quality accessory that represents excellent value. To keep your fridge slide in original condition it is important to care and maintain it following these recommendations:

- Keep the running surfaces of the fridge slide free from abrasive materials like sand, dirt and grit. Wipe the running surfaces clean on a routine basis to avoid causing pitting of the E-coat surface or the bearings.
- As part of any Pre Trip Preparation, or on an annual basis, it is recommended that a thorough visual inspection of the fridge slide is carried out, making sure that all bolts and other components are torqued to the correct specification. Also check that all fittings are free of damage. Replace any components as necessary. This service can be performed by your local authorized ARB Stockist.



The fridge slide has 4 holes cut into the base frame for mounting it to a solid surface. When selecting a location to mount your fridge slide, please take note of the following points:

- The mounting surface must be strong enough to support a fully loaded fridge with the fridge slide at full extension.
- Use M8 high tensile fasteners to attach the fridge slide to the mounting surface.
- Use all 4 mounting holes.
- For best results, the mounting surface should be flat to avoid introducing twist into the fridge slide assembly.
- When mounting to thin or brittle material (eg sheet metal or particle board), use large washers to distribute the load over a large surface area.
- The mounting location should allow 50mm of ventilation on all sides of the fridge.
- Test the fridge slide in location before drilling holes to make sure that full extension/retraction can be achieved
- To ensure accurate location of the fridge slide, use the holes in the base frame as a drilling template.
- Before drilling holes, check on the underside of the mounting surface to ensure that the drill bit and/or mounting hardware will not damage vehicle components like fuel lines, brake lines or fuel tank.

#### NOTE: Mounting hardware is not supplied with the fridge slide.

For ARB Elements Fridge Freezer use tiedown system P/N 10900038


# **Temporary Mounting**

ARB recommends mounting the fridge freezer to the fridge slide using the *appropriate ARB Fridge Freezer Tiedown System* as listed above.

4 holes are provided in the fridge slide to suit the M8 fasteners that are supplied with the tiedown kit.

# Permanent Mounting

Holes are provided in the fridge slide tray to permanently mount your ARB Fridge Freezer to the fridge slide.




#### NOTE: ARB only recommends this method of attachment if the fridge freezer will be PERMANENTLY mounted to the fridge slide.


To fasten the fridge freezer to the fridge tray:

- 1. Remove the M6 bolt that fastens each of the 4 rubber feet to the base of the fridge.
- 2. Position the fridge on the fridge slide and align the feet with the holes in the tray. Make sure that the rubber feet are correctly located between the fridge and the tray.
- 3. Fasten the fridge to the tray using the original M6 bolts making sure that these bolts are not over tightened. ARB recommends using a non permanent thread sealant on these bolts.




